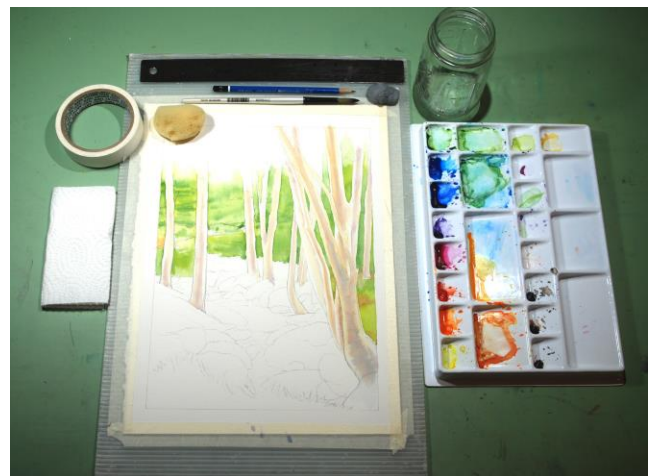


Watercolours: Basics & Beyond

- 2 sheets of Arches 140 lb cold press watercolour paper
 - o Comes in various forms such as blocks, pads and sheets. Sheets are the most economical measuring 22" x 30" inches and should be cut into 4
 - 1 corrugated plastic sheet, white or clear coloured, measuring approximately 12" x 16" to accommodate an 11" x 15" sheet of watercolour paper.
 - o You can buy a large sheet and cut it down or pick up a plain plastic sign from Staples
 - Masking tape
 - 1 pencil - 2H-4H
 - Kneadable eraser
 - Paper towel
 - Ruler
 - Table salt
 - 1 Round #7- #10 watercolour brush with a good point
 - Graphite transfer paper to transfer drawings onto watercolour paper
 - 2 containers for water
 - Watercolour palette with lid
 - Utility knife

- **PAINT:**
 - BASIC PALETTE (can be tubes or pans)
 - Cadmium Yellow **or** Azo Yellow
 - Cadmium Red **or** Permanent Red Light
 - Quinacridone Rose
 - Violet **or** Dioxazine Purple
 - Cerulean Blue
 - Phthalo Blue
 - Sap Green
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Payne's Gray
