An exhibition of drawings by Grazyna Tonkiel and sculpture by Gordon Becker

King artist Grazyna Tonkiel has been celebrating butterflies or the “mystic creatures” as she refers to them with vibrant art pencil and gold leaf drawings for more than two decades. Gordon Becker’s life in art began in earnest when at the age of 11 he was captivated by a film of an Inuit carver creating an image full of magic and power from a raw lump of stone. He decided right then to become a carver.

Together flight² will showcase the exceptional butterfly drawings and wood carvings of these award winning artists. This is an extraordinary, not to be missed, exhibition that is perfect for the whole family. There is a virtual tour through the exhibition and enhance the gallery experience with our Art Bytes series.

Art Bytes include a behind the scenes video, an In Conversation with each artist and one conversation with the artists together. There are two interactive family activities related to the exhibition, a craft demo video and a Name that Butterfly quiz distributed via survey Monkey.

Education Programs

All Q1 programs were originally marketed as in-person at the CFWI-Aurora Armoury and the Aurora Seniors Centre prior to the holiday break. Due to the province-wide Lockdown and Stay-At-Home order that came into effect in early January, we made the decision to shift *all* of our educational programming to a virtual format for the remainder of Q1/Winter season.

We created a comprehensive feedback survey for our patrons which asked them specific questions about their opinion on online classes and workshops. The results from this survey - which had over 130 respondents - helped to inform the format, length, platform, etc. of these virtual programs.

This winter, we are planning to offer the following virtual programs for children/youth and adults. We hope to have one-day workshop offerings as well multi-week classes. Some programs have the option of providing your own materials or opting for a provided Art Kit at curbside pickup. Most classes have both an asynchronous element (i.e. pre-recorded video tutorials that students can watch at their own time and revisit anytime), along with a synchronous element (i.e. lively interactive online sessions where students and instructors interact).

Kaleidoscope in the Schools

In partnership with our local school boards, we have continued to develop teacher professional development workshop sessions with our contracted arts facilitator, Marjie Chud as part of the Kaleidoscope in the Schools program. These sessions will be focus on Arts Integration in the classroom, as we are not yet able to facilitate performance-specific PD.

Designed to support educators during this unique time, the workshop will consider accessibility adaptations and accommodations, apply curriculum connections, explore practical ways to implement and integrate the arts into non-arts curriculum, discuss assessment in the arts, address concerns and questions, and inspire joy for the arts. Handouts will be provided with lesson plans, sample activities, and other arts resources for the classroom.

Administration

- The Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy (CEWS) has been confirmed to continue until June covering a percentage of salaries up to a maximum. Percentages have been confirmed until March 31st. The financial projections have been updated assuming we will receive the wage subsidy through to the end of March as programming in Q1 will be virtual and primarily free for the community. The CEWS is meant to support keeping staff on payroll through this pandemic.
- Applied for Young Canada Works and Canada Summer Jobs for summer positions
- The Town has assembled a Collaborative Leadership Team for culture which includes the Cultural Partners (of which we are one) and additional members of community arts organizations. The purpose is for this team to support the process of building the next Town of Aurora Cultural Master Plan.
- Town IT has transitioned the team to Microsoft 365, a cloud based software solution. We continue to experience email delays. The Town are looking for new solutions.

Human Resources

- Staff meet weekly via Zoom to check in, build future ACC programming and support online initiatives
- Staff continue to work from home during the closure due to the Coronavirus Pandemic.
- Part-time operations staff are once again reduced to zero hours as in-person programming is cancelled for Q1
