## Board of Directors – January 2021 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S UPDATE December 2020

### Live Events Programming

#### **The Bombadils**

December 6<sup>th</sup> 2020

Canadian Folk Music Award nominees The Bombadils are Luke Fraser and Sarah Frank, a vibrant husband and wife duo playing traditional and original music with front porch style and classical grace. Drawing from Canadian, American, and Celtic folk traditions, the two pour the spirit of story-telling and kitchen parties into their song writing. Luke brings guitar, mandolin, and home-grown east coast vocals in harmony with Sarah’s sweet but powerful singing, lyrical fiddle playing, and claw-hammer banjo. This was a free, 1 hour set that was streamed to patrons’ devices straight from Halifax, Nova Scotia.

- 60 unique viewers – viewers assigned a cookie by IP address. So they may be watching on multiple devices within the household or multiple times, but it counts them as 1 viewer
- 162 plays – how many times the “play” button was clicked
- 69 unique loads – how many unique people loaded the page
- 221 page loads – this is how many times the page was loaded in total
- Lots of plays, meaning there may have been some technical lags for patrons, or they opted to replay points of the show they missed
- Patrons had the opportunity to re-watch which was utilized by a lot of patrons

#### **Home for the Holidays**

December 17 – January 4, 2021

A compilation of seven artists performing holiday music which was sent out to our patrons as an e-blast on December 17

- 97 unique viewers - viewers assigned a cookie by IP address. So they may be watching on multiple devices within the household or multiple times, but it counts them as 1 viewer
- 249 plays - how many times the “play” button was hit
- 122 unique loads - how many unique people loaded the page
- 510 loads - this is how many times the page was loaded in total
- We saw most of the plays on the first day they email was sent out. Christmas sees the last big spike of views.

We are getting a far reach with both of these videos. It would be interesting to see how they accessed this information. Future work with Google analytics will be able to tell us this in the future.

An exhibition of drawings by Grazyna Tonkiel and sculpture by Gordon Becker

King artist Grazyna Tonkiel has been celebrating butterflies or the “mystic creatures” as she refers to them with vibrant art pencil and gold leaf drawings for more than two decades. Gordon Becker’s life in art began in earnest when at the age of 11 he was captivated by a film of an Inuit carver creating an image full of magic and power from a raw lump of stone. He decided right then to become a carver.

Together flight<sup>2</sup> will showcase the exceptional butterfly drawings and wood carvings of these award winning artists. This is an extraordinary, not to be missed, exhibition that is perfect for the whole family. There is a virtual tour through the exhibition and enhance the gallery experience with our Art Bytes series.

Art Bytes include a behind the scenes video, an In Conversation with each artist and one conversation with the artists together. There are two interactive family activities related to the exhibition, a craft demo video and a Name that Butterfly quiz distributed via survey Monkey.

### **Education Program**

Classes continuing into December. We were able to complete all but two classes before lockdown.

We had planned for winter classes to take place at the Armoury however due to the lockdown, we will shift to program as many online as possible. York Region Public Health has given written advice that we can continue virtual programs with curbside pickup throughout the stay at home order. Receipt of materials for educational classes is an exception in the order.

### **Administration**

- The Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy (CEWS) has been confirmed to continue until March 31<sup>st</sup> covering a percentage of salaries up to a maximum. The CEWS is meant to support keeping staff on payroll through this pandemic.
- Submitted a multi-year application to the TD Ready Commitment to support KITS

### **Human Resources**

- Staff meet weekly via Zoom to check in, build future ACC programming and support online initiatives
- Staff continue to work from home during the closure due to the Coronavirus Pandemic.
- Part-time operations staff are once again reduced to zero hours as in-person programming is cancelled for Q1

- Staff holidays ranged from December 14 – January 8 over the winter break. There were no office hours from December 21 – January 1.

### **Facilities**

- Piano maintenance and remediation has been completed. A new humidifier requires monitoring. Town facility staff have agreed to take on this weekly task to limit the number of people attending Town Hall.
- We have been granted access to the Program Room as necessary to create kits for our educational and outreach programs.
